Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the last seven days, our lives have been significantly impacted by the Coronavirus. Earlier this week, the Holy Synod of the Russian Orthodox Church published more detailed guidelines on conducting Divine Services amidst the COVID-19 (Coronavirus)¹. Clergy and laity are exhorted to implement extra precautionary procedures and to strictly follow the recommendations of health and governmental agencies in order to reduce the chance of spreading this disease.

Furthermore, just yesterday, the State of Maryland announced updated restrictions that have the force of law². **All social gatherings of 10 and more people are prohibited.**

And so, we at Holy Trinity Church must implement these new restrictions, effective immediately.

- Divine Services will continue, but attendance will be limited **to only nine individuals:**
 - Only clergy, certain choir members and parish council members will attend
- Liturgies and vigils will be live-streamed: <https://www.youtube.com/user/HolyTrinitySermons>
 - We strongly encourage everyone to pray along with us, on-line.
- The Passion Service scheduled for March 22 is canceled
- All Presanctified Liturgies are canceled
- Moleben services "During times of pestilence" will also be live streamed once a week.
 - We strongly encourage everyone to pray along with us, on-line.
 - The days/times of these molebens will be announced in the bulletin
- All other activities are canceled
